## **Mission Statement**

The Anglican Church Twente, founded in 1979, provides Christian ministry to people living in an area with a radius of 50 km, centred on St Mary's Chapel, Weldam, encompassing the towns of Almelo, Apeldoorn, Deventer, Enschede, Hengelo, Oldenzaal, Winterswijk and Zutphen. It belongs to the Anglican Diocese in Europe, a diocese of the Church of England, and is part of the worldwide Anglican Communion of some 70 million people.

The four main activities are:

- 1. Worship in the weekly Sunday Eucharist and other services according to the rites of the Church of England.
- 2. Providing a pastoral ministry to all who are in need of such.
- 3. Promoting a lively fellowship between all who attend the services.
- 4. Outreach in support of the Christian ministry in developing countries.

Persons of all nationalities are welcomed. Holy Communion is open to all baptized Christians. Services are held every Sunday at 10:30 am, and are normally in English.
